



Notice About Due Dates for Payments with Your Return.

As you have heard, the IRS is providing certain relief by delaying the time for payments to be made with your tax return. We also suspect that other changes will be made in the future. Because of this fluid situation, the answers may change in the near future.

Federal:

April 15 – Your income tax return is no longer due. The filing date has been changed to July 15. The payment with your return and 1st quarter estimate is due July 15.

(June 15 - If you have a second quarter estimated payment for 2020, this date has not been extended and the payment will still be due. However, we expect the IRS to change this in the near future and move it back until at least July 15, if not later).

July 15 - Due date for your income tax return and 1st quarter estimated tax payment.

Indiana:

An Indiana press release dated March 19, 2020, states that Individual tax returns and payments originally due by April 15, 2020 are now due on or before July 15, 2020. Forms include IT-40, IT-40PRN, IT-40RNR, IT-40ES, ES-40 and SC-40.

The press release also states that Corporate, Partnership and Fiduciary income tax returns and payments originally due by April 15 or April 20 are now due on July 15, 2020. Returns originally due on May 15th are now due on August 17, 2020. Returns included are IT-20, IT-41, IT-65, IT20S, FIT-20, URT-1, IT-6, FT-QP and URT-Q.

All other Indiana tax return filings and payment due dates remain the same. We expect the June 15th estimated tax payment will also be extended, but at this time it has not been
